Sixth Form Dress Code 2018

We strive to maintain high standards of dress at Magnus and encourage parents to support us in ensuring our students arrive for the day looking smart. Not only does this teach students the importance of presenting themselves appropriately, but it also prepares them for the world of work when uniforms or dress codes are necessary. This is particularly important for Sixth Form students who are preparing for Higher Education or employment within the next 2 years.

The Sixth Form Dress Code encompasses a **business suit** that all students must wear.

The Sixth Form Dress Code is as follows:

Female students:

Grey Suit Jacket

Grey Suit Trousers

Grey Pencil Skirt (knee length – must meet the knee)

Suits can be purchased from school (limited stock) or from high street retailers. The suit must be business style and not fashion. Jackets and trousers/skirts are to match in colour.

White collared shirt

Sixth Form tie or Scarf (***This can be purchased from school***)

Black shoes – that can be polished. (Stilettos, wedges, kitten heels, UGG boots and trainers are not permitted)

Coat

Bag – to fit an A4 ring binder

Jewellery – female students are permitted to wear a watch, 1 necklace, and studs in the ear. **Bracelets, rings and any other forms of jewellery are not permitted. Piercings are only permitted in the ear.**

Hair – to be natural in colour, no extreme hairstyles are permitted

Make-up – discreet make up is permitted. Female students may wear natural coloured nail varnish only. Nail extensions are not permitted but students may wear natural coloured gel nail varnish. No visible tattoos.



Male students:

Grey Suit Jacket

Grey Suit Trousers

Suits can be purchased from school (limited stock) or from high street retailers. The suit must be business style and not fashion. Jackets and trousers are to match in colour.

White collared shirt

Sixth Form tie

Black shoes – that can be polished. (Trainers and boots are not permitted)

Coat – to be dark in colour

Bag – to fit an A4 ring binder

Jewellery – male students are permitted to wear a watch and studs in the ears. Other forms of jewellery are not permitted. Piercings are only permitted in the ear.

No visible tattoos.

In line with Academy policy, Sixth Form students are not permitted to use mobile phones on the Academy site. As a privilege Sixth Form students can use mobile phones in the common room at break and lunch time only. If a student chooses to bring a mobile phone on site it must be in their bag and switched off whilst on site, when not in the common room, or it will be confiscated as per the whole Academy policy.



Suits for male and female students are not to be skin tight, patterned or made of shiny, reflective material.
