**Magnus Academy Transition Arrangements – PLEASE NOTE IF YOUR CHILD IS SELF ISOLATING THEY MUST NOT ATTEND.**

I'm excited to confirm that, despite the difficulties we currently face, after careful consideration and with the agreement from primary school headteachers, we are going ahead with the year 6 Magnus Transition, which takes place next week, from Monday 5<sup>th</sup> to Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July. As we consider transition to secondary school to be vital for year 6 students we are working hard to put in place rigorous systems to ensure all government guidelines regarding Covid are followed and requests from primary schools are satisfied.

To allow for current Magnus students to enter school in their bubbles please bring your child to the Magnus Academy Sports Centre entrance reached via Bowbridge Road on the morning of 5<sup>th</sup> July at 8.45am where members of the senior leadership team will be available to greet you and direct your child to their primary school bubble. We ask parents to adhere to social distancing guidelines and leave the site immediately to allow for this.

The arrangements for your child on the transition days will be as follows:

- Arrive at Magnus sports centre entrance at 8.45am where our senior staff will meet you. (Your child must attend school on these days and any absences will be reported to primary schools first thing for registers to be marked accordingly).
- Attend in primary school uniform, except on Wednesday when students should wear PE kit.
- A free lunch will be provided each day. Students will be able to choose from the main meal or a freshly made roll. Please send your child in with a water bottle and a snack for break time.
- Students should bring basic equipment to include 2 blue or black pens, 2 pencils, rubber, pencil sharpener, ruler.
- Magnus school day will finish at 3.00pm. Bubbles will be released one at a time and your child will be released to walk home unless you advise us otherwise. If you are collecting your child, please meet them at the Sports Centre reception and maintain social distancing.
- If your child has medication in school time which your primary school is administering, please request that they share this information with Magnus.
