What is Prayer?

Let's start with what prayer isn't. Prayer isn't having fancy words or a pre-planned shopping lists of requests. Prayer isn't something that just vicars or super religious people do. Prayer isn't boring. Prayer isn't just wishful thinking. Prayer isn't a vending machine interaction.

Prayer is being able to talk to God, the Creator, about what is happening in your life. Prayer is joyful and something that people are a lot better at than we often think! Prayer instills hope. Prayer ignites a peace beyond human understanding. Prayer is having that open conversation with God about how you're feeling, about good things and bad things. Just like you would need to talk to your friends in order to have a friendship with them, people talk to God in order to grow in their friendship with Him.

If you have never prayed before, you can start by just telling God about your day. What things are you hoping for? What things are you fearful of? Is there anything you want help with? Nothing you say will shock God, He already knows! But loves it when we share with Him.

Ways of praying:

- Journaling or writing a letter to God
- Get creative! You might draw, paint or dance out how you are feeling or what you are thinking
- With other people or by yourself
- Praying through worship songs
- Following other people's prayers (e.g. Ignatius' Prayers)
- Crying or shouting
- Speaking out loud or in your head

Did you know?

Amen means "so be it", as found in the early scriptures of the Bible is a word of Hebrew **origin**. So when we say 'Amen' at the end of a prayer, we are saying 'We agree!' or 'Let it be so'.
