

## **Destinations 2024 - 2025**

2024 – 2025 was a very successful year for our students and their futures, both after GCSE and Post-18. Lots of our previous Year 11 students decided to rejoin Magnus and attend the Magnus 6<sup>th</sup> Form (30.5%) to further their studies, whilst a large number have opted for pastures new and joined a Further Education College (59.5%), Apprenticeships (1.6%) or other education provider (such as a scholarship at a football club) (4.1%).

We have also seen an increase in the variety of universities our Post-18 students are attending, with students attending the following Universities; Nottingham Trent University, University of Staffordshire, Leeds Beckett University, University of York and University of Plymouth, among others.
