Re: Prison Me No Way Visit

I am writing to inform you that on Monday 9th February (year 8) and Tuesday 10th (year 9) February we have a visit from the external provider Prison Me No Way! This will include a full day off timetable in which your child will participate in a Crime Awareness Day.

Prison Me No Way! are a registered national charity with over 30 years' experience. Their aim is to ensure every young person leaves school with the knowledge and confidence to take control, make positive choices that avoid being involved in crime, stay safe and achieve their full potential. Their visits to school help young people develop peer respect and awareness of dangers they may be inadvertently subjected to.

This visit will include real-life learning experiences for children and young people to help reduce risky behaviour and prevent them from becoming involved in crime. The day will encourage our pupils to think carefully about the decisions they make throughout their lives, keep themselves safe and help them to manage the temptations of modern society.

This is the second year the Academy will be hosting Prison Me No Way! and it is a highly sought after visit amongst schools and pupils within this area. We are delighted that they are able to visit our Academy and compliment the topics covered in our personal development curriculum.

The visit has been individually tailored to crime and safety issues in the local area and offers various relevant sessions throughout the day, including prison life; railway network safety; risky behaviour (knife crime); county lines and choices and consequences – a session where an ex-offender shares personal stories about how bad decisions led to their imprisonment. Sessions are led by retired prison officers, youth engagement officers, ex-offenders and volunteers.
