Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that the NHS School Aged Immunisation Service will be visiting Magnus Church of England Academy on **Tuesday 28th April** to offer the HPV (Human Papillomavirus) vaccination to students in Year 8.

The vaccination session will be delivered and managed entirely by the NHS. The academy's role is limited to hosting the session and supporting student supervision on the day. Consent is also managed by the NHS, not the academy. The NHS team will check their records on the day to confirm whether consent has been given online.

Because the vaccinations are organised and administered by the NHS, the academy is unable to answer questions or deal with any queries relating to the HPV vaccination itself. Any questions about the vaccine, consent, or medical matters must be directed to the NHS School Aged Immunisation Service using the contact details provided in their communications.

We will inform the NHS team that the school **does not support** young people giving their own consent and will make it clear that they **may only vaccinate students for whom they have the required online consent** recorded.

If you do not wish for your child to receive the HPV vaccination, please email the school office at office@magnusacademy.co.uk. We will ensure the NHS vaccination team is informed that your child is not to be immunised.

About the HPV vaccine

The HPV vaccine helps protect against Human Papillomavirus, a very common virus that most people will come into contact with at some point in their lives. Some types of HPV are linked to serious health conditions later in life, including cervical cancer and other cancers of the mouth, throat, anus, and genitals. The vaccine is routinely offered to all children in Year 8 across England and is recommended by the NHS as a safe and effective way to provide long-term protection.
